The New England Rugby Union is one of Australia's oldest rugby competitions, certainly in non-metropolitan areas. An inter-district rugby competition commenced in New England in 1886 when Armidale played Glen Innes, with the result a nil-all draw. This game came shortly after the formation of the Rugby Football Union in England in 1871 and the formation of Sydney Rugby Union in 1874.

New England Rugby Union was formed at a meeting at the St Kilda Hotel on 21 March 1893.

The William Sawers Shield, which is awarded to the 1st Grade Premiers today, is the oldest trophy in country rugby in Australia. The trophy was donated by William Sawers, the first Federal Member for the seat of New England in the Federal Parliament, in 1902.

Enjoy the day and I wish each of the teams playing today the best of luck and enjoy your rugby.
